NYS ATSA Student Travel Award honors outstanding undergraduate and graduate students who are interested in becoming involved in the sex offender management field. The award provides a stipend to help defray travel expenses and provide complimentary meeting registration fees for the NYS ATSA Annual Conference. The award is limited to undergraduate or graduate students who are student affiliate members of NYS ATSA. Awardees are chosen based on the merit of the application and letters of recommendation.

To be considered for a NYS ATSA Travel Award, please send a letter of application and one recommendation letter from a professor or dissertation/thesis advisor. The application letter should be brief (one to two pages) and should include:

- your name and contact information
- your university or college
- the name of the person providing the recommendation letter
- a description of your studies and interest in the sex offender management field
- a statement indicating why it is important to attend the NYS ATSA Annual conference
- an estimate of the travel expenses you will incur

Applications are due no later than April 1, 2012. Award winners will be notified by April 30, 2012.
